MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2018.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Greg Barnett with members Rusty Eddy and Tom Heidenwirth present. Also present were Engineer John Riherd, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter, County Attorney Greg Lievens, Sheriff Jason Johnson, Assessor Michele Shultz, Treasurer Vicki Schoneman, New Hartford City Attorney Tom Lawler, Parkersburg, Iowa, New Hartford City Engineer Lyle TeKippe, West Union Iowa, City Clerk Shawna Hagen, Gordy Ballhagen, Jane Close and Mayor John Anderson, all of New Hartford, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board had a moment of silence in remembrance of 9/11/2001.

Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to continue with The Accel Group and review yearly. All ayes. Motion carried.

Board discussed the recent water damage to the carpet in the Courthouse basement. Carpet has been wet multiple times and will have to be torn-up and replaced with a suitable product.

Board discussed the annexation of real estate into City of New Hartford. Concerns were addressed regarding the involuntary annexations, utilities to the site, the lack of dual entrances into the annexed area and possession of the road. Following discussion, it was moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to support the Resolution allowing real estate to be annexed into the City of New Hartford as described with future 28E Agreements to work out necessary details. City of New Hartford (Parcels 16-27-300-042 & 16-27-300-043) – Whole Waste Water Treatment Plant Site All of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W 1/2 SW 1/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Ninety (90) North, Range Fifteen (15) West of the Fifth P.M., Butler County, Iowa, except a tract described as follows:

Thence South 50.0 feet along the West Line of said Section 34 and the East Line of the existing Corporation Line of the City of New Hartford, Butler County, Iowa;

Thence Northeasterly to a point that is on the North Line of said Section 34, being 50.0 feet East of the Northwest Corner of said Section 34;

Thence West 50.0 feet along the North Line of said Section 34 to the Pont of Beginning.
