

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION
TO DECLARE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
TO BE AN ESSENTIAL SERVICE IN BUTLER COUNTY, IA**

The Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa, will meet at 9:00 a.m. on March 30, 2022, in the Butler County Courthouse, Allison, Iowa for the first of three consecutive, weekly meetings to consider a resolution by Butler County to declare emergency medical services (EMS) to be an essential county service as authorized by Iowa Code Section 422D.1.

At that time and place, the proposal to consider an adoption of a resolution that will allow for an election to be offered for voter approval of an ad valorem property tax not to exceed seventy-five cents per one thousand dollars of assessed value for EMS and the creation of a county emergency medical services system advisory council to assist in researching and assessing the service needs of the county and guide implementation of the same under Iowa Code Section 422D.1.
